

Career Development Events

Agricultural Issues Forum – Cost - \$150

Teams research a local agricultural topic & develop a presentation. (\$100 Awards, \$50 Scholarship*)

Agricultural Technology & Mechanical Systems – Cost - \$1,750

Teams develop skills in all areas of mechanical repair. (\$150 Awards, \$100 Scholarship*, \$500 Adult Consultant, \$1,000 Supplies)

Agricultural Sales – Cost - \$400

Teams develop sales skills & customer satisfaction. (\$150 Awards, \$200 Scholarship*, \$50 Supplies)

Agriscience – Cost - \$50 (Awards)

Students conduct & present a science project.

Best Informed Greenhand – Cost - \$200

First year members are tested on their knowledge of Agriculture Education. (\$150 Awards, \$50 Scholarship*)

Creed Speaking – Cost - \$150

Freshmen members recite the FFA Creed. (\$50 Awards, \$100 Scholarship*)

Dairy Cattle Management & Evaluation Cost \$800

Teams select & rank dairy cattle for production. (\$150 Awards, \$100 Scholarship*, \$150 Stock Use, \$400 Official)

Environmental Natural Resources – Cost - \$200

Students must analyze a setting, solve an environmental issue, and present their findings. (\$150 Awards, \$50 Supplies)

Extemporaneous Public Speaking – Cost - \$150

Students are given 30 minutes to prepare a speech on an agriculture topic. (\$50 Awards, \$100 Scholarship*)

Farm Business Management

(Junior & Senior Levels) – Cost - \$400

Students learn all skill areas to manage a modern farm. (\$300 Awards, \$100 Scholarship*)

Floriculture – Cost - \$2,400

Teams identify various plant types, determine health condition, & arrange floral material. (\$150 Awards, \$250 Scholarship*, \$1,500 Supplies, \$500 Adult Consultant)

Horse Evaluation – Cost - \$600

Teams evaluate equine based on performance. (\$150 Awards, \$300 Scholarship*, \$150 Stock Use)

Job Interview – Cost - \$100

Students are evaluated on their resume, cover letter & interview. (\$50 Awards, \$50 Supplies)

Livestock Evaluation – Cost - \$1,650

Teams evaluate livestock—production & carcass qualities (\$150 Awards, \$600 Scholarship*, \$300 Stock Use, \$600 Travel)

Marketing Plan – Cost - \$250

Teams develop a plan & market all areas of an agricultural business/product. (\$150 Awards, \$100 Scholarship*)

Meats Evaluation & Technology – Cost - \$1,000

Teams display skills in consumer meat & meat products. (\$150 Awards, \$500 Adult Consultant, \$350 Supplies)

Milk Quality & Products – Cost - \$950

Members identify & determine quality of various dairy products. (\$150 Awards, \$300 Supplies, \$500 Adult Consultant)

Nursery Landscape – Cost - \$600

Teams learn to maintain plants & all related aspects, including landscape design. (\$150 Awards, \$100 Scholarship*, \$350 Plant Use)

Parliamentary Procedure – Cost - \$1,000

Team competition demonstrates proper & effective participation in a meeting. (\$300 Awards, \$100 Scholarship, \$500 Adult Consultant, \$100 Supplies)

Poultry Evaluation – Cost - \$250

Teams display knowledge of the poultry industry. (\$150 Awards, \$100 Supplies)

Prepared Public Speaking – Cost - \$150

Members give a prepared speech based on a current agricultural issue. (\$50 Awards, \$100 Scholarship*)

Range – Cost - \$400

Students identify range plant species & evaluate the condition of the rangeland. (\$150 Awards, \$50 Supplies, \$200 Travel)

Rituals – Cost - \$200

Freshmen members must correctly perform the FFA opening ceremonies. (\$150 Awards, \$100 Student Scholarship*)

Soils & Homesite – Cost - \$550

Students determine various soil types/qualities. (\$300 Awards & \$50 Supplies, \$200 Travel)

Veterinary Medicine – Cost - \$400

Students demonstrate knowledge & skills in veterinary care. (\$150 Awards, \$50 Supplies, \$200 Scholarship*)

Individuals are awarded based on their Supervised Agricultural Experiences in addition to their involvement in FFA and the agricultural education classroom.
