

## Nevada FFA Degree Application Advisor Process



### Prior to submitting to state:

For each of your students' applications, make sure you do the following before the application is submitted at Winter Leadership Training:

- Sign the front signature page.
- Review the final "Manual checklist" page. Check the appropriate boxes under the "Advisor" column. On #6 – Additional Requirements, please have the student document the year the activity was completed and where it is noted in their journal. Add any comments you'd like the reviewers to know regarding the additional requirements and sign the document.

**NOTE: Since additional requirements are not validated by AET, the review committee will utilize the year and journal locations to verify the completion of the items.**

7. Have participated in the planning and completion of the chapter program of Activities.
8. Have participated in at least five different FFA activities above the chapter level.
9. Have participated in at least 25 hours of community service, within at least 2 different community service activities approved by the local advisor. These hours are in addition to and cannot be duplicated as paid or unpaid SAE hours.
10. Chapter Advisor approval.
11. State approval.

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- 4) Click on the student’s hyperlinked name to drill down to the specific section. From there you can click on the first column hyperlinks to see the specific information they need to update.

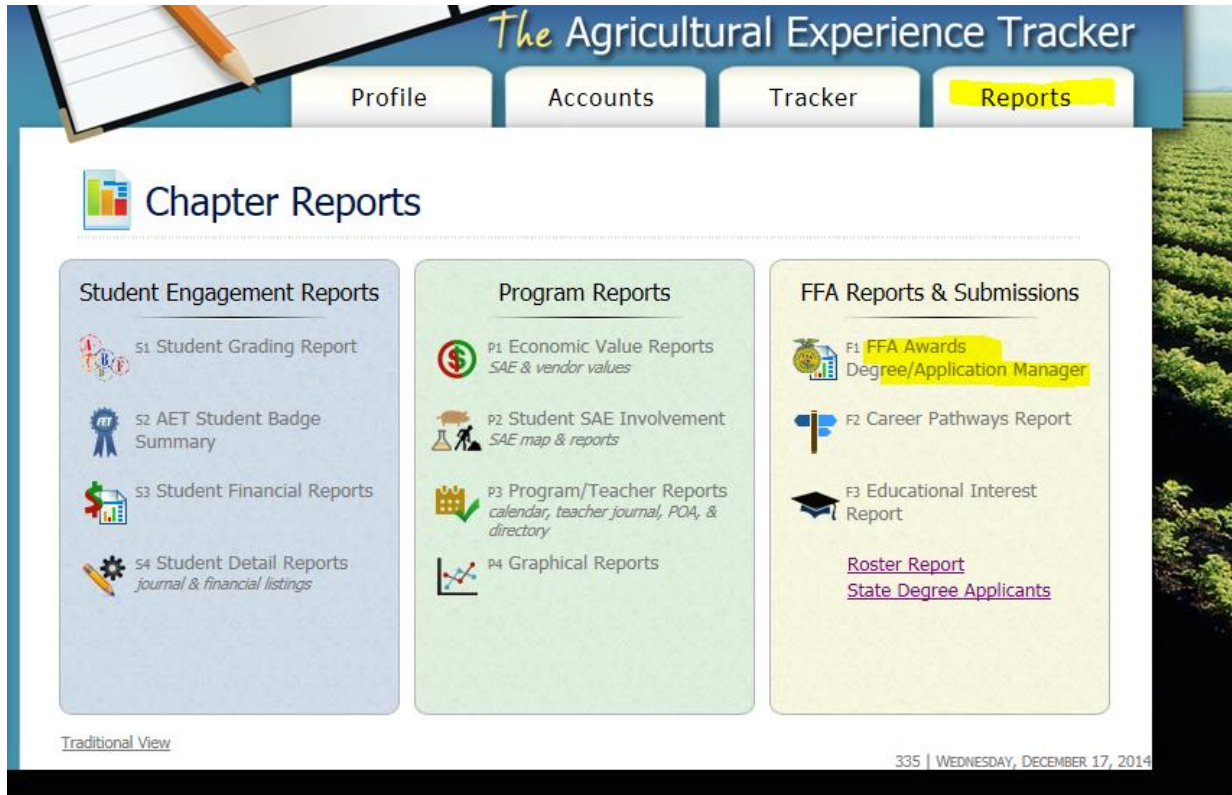
